A TRIBUTE TO SUSANNA DOYLE



West Side Montessori School mourns the passing of Susanna Doyle on September 4, 2023. A founding member of WSMS, Susanna's foresight, boldness, and innovative ideas forever changed the landscape of early childhood education. As Susanna's background in education infused her work throughout her life, it was also integral to her key role in

the creation of our school.* When, in the 1960s, she and her husband and their close friends realized there was a significant lack of early childhood options on the Upper West Side, she committed to addressing that need.

The Doyles worked with four other couples to find an experienced Montessori teacher and opened WSMS. Susanna became the school's director for its first ten years, working with Elizabeth Hopkins, the first Montessori teacher, to hire additional teachers and move the school multiple times as it grew.

Susanna left WSMS to work for Citizens' Committee for Children as an education policy analyst and then went to

Advocates for Children of New York in the same role, all while raising her four daughters. She wrote speeches and papers for myriad civic organizations, and eventually for the Chancellor of the NYC Board of Education in the mid-1980s. In the 1990s she worked with investigative reporter Wayne Barrett at the *Village Voice*, and also wrote some pieces on a freelance basis. All the while, she served on a number of boards, doing important work for institutions such as Berkshire Farm Center and St. Luke's—Roosevelt Hospital.

We are so grateful to have been a beneficiary of Susanna's lifetime of professional accomplishments, which had a major impact on so many children and families in New York.

Susanna is survived by her husband, Boker, her four daughters Katharine, Nancy, Victoria, and Jessica, their husbands Tim, Gerard, Walied, and Joshua, and her six beautiful grandchildren.
